- b. Supplier's name and signature, telephone number.
- c. Type of operation and the acreage cultivated.
- d. A 10 cent Barbados stamp for receipts and rubber paid stamp for invoices.

NB: All invoices and receipts must be submitted within THREE (3) MONTHS of services rendered.

Rebates will only be for approved systems, which do not breach the laws of Barbados and meet the requirements of the Ministry of Agriculture.

A one-time rebate of 50% up to a maximum of \$10,000 for an approved farm security system on farm.
